KEY PASSAGE: 1 PETER 4:7-11

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Serve your King with the right motivations and goals; Serve one another as good stewards of your King's gifts.*

1. In what ways can our prayers be affected by being “self-controlled and sober minded” or NOT being self-controlled and sober minded”?

2. Please compare verse 8 with Proverbs 10:12 and 19:11. How does being self-controlled and sober minded help us to love others?

3. For what 2 purposes does God want us to use the gifts He gives us?

4. What wrong motivations can drive us to use our gifts, or keep us from using our gifts?

5. According to verse 11, how does God want us to use our gifts? How does using our gifts God's way keep us from getting burned out?

6. What in this passage gives you reason to worship God for His:

a. Power?

b. Wisdom?

c. Love?

7. How does Jesus' life exemplify the commands in this passage?
