

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: EXODUS 34:1-9, 29-30

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Mountaintop impact results in God's restoration and mercy; Mountaintop impact results in our obedience to God; Mountaintop impact results in humble repentance and respect; Mountaintop impact affects body and soul.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. How does God's command to "cut two tablets of stone like the first" show His heart of mercy and restoration? (Please see Exodus 32:1-20 for context.)

2. What attributes of God are displayed through God's command in verse 3?

3. Please describe the words God used to proclaim His name (which signify His character and reputation). Then, describe their opposite meanings.

a. Merciful

b. Gracious

c. Slow to anger

d. Abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness

e. Forgiving iniquity

f. Not clearing the guilty

4. Please compare Ezekiel 18:20 with Exodus 34:7, which says God “visits the iniquity of the fathers on children to the third and fourth generation.” Since the children are not responsible for their fathers’ sins, what does this mean?

5. What is Moses’ request in verse 9? What evidence does verse 10 give as to God’s answer to his request?

6. Please note the evidence seen in Moses that he had been in the presence of God in verse 29. What evidence do you see in people who spend time with God today in our culture?

7. What attributes of God are most impactful to your life in your present circumstances? Of which attributes do you need to grow in your understanding?
