

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 2:24-25 & SONG 4:9-12,16B,5:16

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? Celebrate spiritual and relational oneness in physical oneness: Let the physical oneness you enjoy come from a captivated heart for each other: Let the physical oneness be an expression of your spiritual and relational oneness.

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Genesis 2:24-25, Song of Solomon 4:9-12, 16b, 5:16 and answer the following questions:

1. From Genesis 2:24-25, please describe the depth of intimacy the Lord wants for a husband and wife.

2. Song of Solomon 4:9-12 is written from the perspective of “he” and verse 16b is written from the perspective of “she”. Please describe the mutual affection God wants between a husband and wife. What obstacles hinder this physical oneness?

3. From Song of Solomon 5:16:

- a. What insight does Song of Solomon 5:16 give to the importance of relational and spiritual oneness as the basis for physical oneness?

b. What is one step you can take toward pursuing the whole oneness the Lord wants our marriages to have?

c. If you're married or single, what is one step you can take toward pursuing that oneness with the Lord as the bride of Christ?

4. What do you learn about the heart of God toward marriage and toward His relationship with His bride (believers) from these passages?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

What is one thing from this passage that you will apply to your life—in your actions, thoughts, or desires—to better center your worship on the Lord?
