1. This psalm is David's prayer to God after Nathan the prophet confronted him for his sin with Bathsheba and Uriah. What evidence do you find that David was feeling the weight of his sin even before he was confronted?

2. What things did David say that showed his view of God?

3. 2 Corinthians 7:10 says, "For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death." Please use the following passages to explain how David's grief over his sin was godly, and what worldly grief might look like.

a. Proverbs 15:31-32

b. Proverbs 24:16

c. Proverbs 28:13

d. Proverbs 29:1

4. How does God's confrontation of our sin display His mercy?

5. What reasons do you find in this passage to surrender to God and behold His glory?
