IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: GALATIANS 5:16-26

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Be led by the Spirit who opposes our selfish flesh; Deny the desires of the flesh; Keep in step with the Holy Spirit who supernaturally transforms our toxic heart to the heart of Christ.*

1. Please look at the descriptions of the works of the flesh and the description of the fruit of the Spirit. How do you see these things being opposed to one another?

2. Why do you think the traits of the flesh are described as “works” while the traits of the Spirit are described as “fruit”?

3. The description of the fruit of the Spirit is ONE fruit, not many, even though there are many qualities. Why do you think this is significant?

4. Please list the commands in this passage and summarize in your own words what God is calling us to do. What is hard about doing this, and what is liberating?
