4.	Genesis 1:27 describes God's intent to "make man in His image". From verse 7, how did God do that? How is that different than with the rest of the living creatures He formed?
5.	From 1 Corinthians 15:45-49, what do believers share in common with the first Adam? What do we share in common with the second Adam, Jesus?
6.	What do you see from Genesis 2:1-7 that makes God worthy to be worshiped and followed? What obstacles get in the way of bowing to Him?
