Please read Genesis 6:9-7:10 and answer the following:

1. Please use Genesis 6:22 and 7:5 to explain the observable evidence of Genesis 6:9, that Noah “was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.”

2. How do you think the corrupt people would have responded to God if He had commanded any of them to build the ark? Please explain your answer.

3. Imagine you are Noah living among such corrupt people. How do you think Noah kept from being drawn into their corruption?

4. How specific was God in telling Noah how to build the ark? What does this tell you about His authority and wisdom?

5. What hope does God give Noah for his future in verses 18-21?

6. Some people say that this story of Noah is just a story, but not real. How do the following passages refute that claim?

- a. Matthew 24:37-39 (notice who is speaking)

- b. 1 Peter 3:20

- c. 2 Peter 2:5

7. What attributes of God do you see in this passage that:

- a. Help you have confidence because of His involvement in your life?

- b. Make Him worthy of our obedience, not out of duty, but delight?
