Inform the Head, Stir the Heart

Please read Matthew 19:1-9, 1 Corinthians 7:12-13, 15 and answer the following questions:

1. From Matthew 19:1-9, of all the reasons marriages suffer, why do you think God gave adultery as one of the only reasons the covenant of marriage could be broken? How does “hardness of heart” lead to other justifications for divorce?

2. From 1 Corinthians 7:12-13, 15, what is the reason given for biblical divorce? What role does the believing spouse have in breaking the covenant?

3. Please consider that we are called the bride of Christ.

- a. From Matthew 19, whose heart is hard and who commits adultery in relation to Jesus and the bride?

- b. From 1 Corinthians 7, what do you learn about God’s position with the one who chooses to leave?

4. What do you learn about the heart of God toward His bride, the believers, from these passages? How does putting God first affect our faith and actions when we’re in a struggling marriage?
