IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS KEY PASSAGE: LUKE 19:28-40

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? Follow Jesus the Messiah willingly and worshipfully; Celebrate and worship Jesus, the Messiah and eternal King.

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. What did Jesus tell His disciples to do and how did it work out? What does the disciples' response to Jesus tell you about their faith?

2. What do you learn about the action of our faith from this passage? How might the disciples have responded to Jesus if they had no faith?

3. Please compare this passage with Zechariah 9:9, a prophecy written over 500 years earlier. What impact does fulfilled prophecy have on your faith and your view of God?

4. How did the multitude of disciples respond to Jesus when He rode into Jerusalem? What memories do you think might have motivated their response?

5. How would you describe the Pharisees' faith based on their actions? What do you think motivated their faith or lack of it?

6. Please compare Jesus' response to the Pharisees (vs. 40) with Matthew 27:50-51. How might what Jesus said to the Pharisees been foreshadowing of what was to come?

7. What do you see in this passage that displays the supernatural power, authority, and wisdom of Jesus?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned in Sunday's message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
