IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: PSALM 19:1-6

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? See clearly the glory and authority of the LORD in all of creation; See the glory of the LORD in the sun.

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1.	This psalm was a song given to the choirmaster, to have it sung by a choir. Why do you think these lyrics would be intended to be sung over and over?
2.	Please use Exodus 33:18-19 to describe God's glory that is declared in the heavens.
3.	From verse 2, please consider the proclamation of the sky. What knowledge about God does it reveal?
4.	Verses 2-4 say the voice of the message from day and night aren't heard, yet they still reveal knowledge. How is their message communicated without words?

5.	Please look ahead to verses 7-9. While the message from night and day is not heard audibly, what IS heard audibly? Why do you think God makes sure the message from verses 7-9 is clearly heard?
6.	Please describe what this passage says about the sun. What insight does its description give you about the character of God?
7.	Please share what attributes of God you see in this passage. What attribute impacts you the most in your present circumstances? Why?
