

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: ROMANS 1:18-23

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *See God's wrath against our sin as just and right; See God's eternal power in creation as leaving us without excuse; Set aside all self-centered idols and bow before the Creator King.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please look back at verses 16-17. Through what is God's righteousness revealed? From verses 18-19, why is God's wrath revealed? What place does faith have in His righteousness versus His wrath?

2. From the sermon, what are three ways we may suppress truth? What is at the center of every suppression of truth?

3. Please give examples of God's eternal power and divine nature expressed in His creation.

4. According to verse 21, why are people who reject God without excuse? How can we honor God in our attitudes and behaviors toward those who suppress the truth?

5. Why do you think people reject God, knowing that His attributes are clearly seen in creation?

6. Please compare verses 22-23 with John 12:42-43. What things in our culture do you see as temptations that entice people to choose them in place of the glory of God?

7. For believers, this passage can serve as a “what not to do as a follower of Christ” list. Using the “what not to do’s”, what are the things we CAN do as an expression of our faith in the Lord? (Example...Rather than suppressing the truth by unrighteousness, reveal the truth by our obedience to it.)

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned in Sunday’s message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
