

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: ROMANS 1:24-32

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Bow before your Creator, not your feelings, or the death spiral will begin; Turn back from your lusts, or your passions will continue to spiral down; Repent of sin, or your heart will hit rock bottom, redefining bad as good.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. In Romans 1:24, what is the “therefore” there for?

2. From verses 24-25, what did “God give them up” to? For what reason did He give them up?

3. From verses 26-27, what did “God give them up” to? For what reason did He give them up?

4. From verses 28-31, what did “God give them up” to? For what reason did He give them up?

5. What insight does this passage give you about the phrase, “follow your heart”?

6. From verse 32:

a. What do the people that God “gave over” know about God’s righteous decrees?

b. How do they respond to His righteous decrees?

c. How do they respond to others who disobey God’s righteous decrees?

7. As believers, what ways can we handle the lusts of our hearts, our dishonorable passions, and how do we acknowledge God in a way that honor’s Him?
