

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-8

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Love the same way God loves, not the way the world does; Love with a never-ending love.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. For each word that describes love in the passage, put that word or phrase into your own words.

2. Since we know that God IS love, please read your list out loud with “God is _____ with/to/for your name.” (Ex. God is patient with Bob... God is kind to Bob...)

3. Recently, what qualities of God’s love toward you have you experienced the most ? Why?

4. How would the world respond to this list of what love is?

5. Please use that same list to put your name in the place of love. (Bob is patient with _____. Bob is kind to ... _____) What does that show you about ways you can grow in loving others?

6. Verse 6 says “Love does not rejoice with wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth.” Consider a scenario where someone you love is doing something wrong. How is supporting them in what they’re doing NOT love? (What is the difference between enabling and loving?)

7. How can abiding in the Lord (CHAT...connect, hear, agree, trust) help you grow in loving others as defined in this passage?

8. Verse 8 says, “Love never fails.” (NIV) Looking at the list of what love is, how does knowing God never fails in any of it deepen your understanding of Him and your worship?

Based on what you learned in Sunday’s message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
