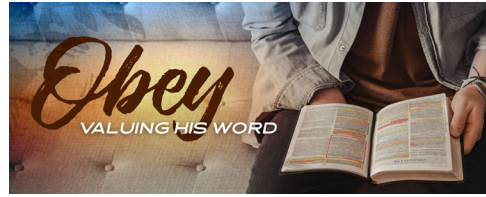

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: PSALM 19:7-14

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Head: Know God's Word, His special revealing of Himself; Heart: Be stirred and impacted by God's Word; Will: Apply God's Word to your life, for His glory!*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Psalm 19:1-6 defines the general revelation of God in this world. This revealing is general because it is shown in creation for all to see. However, Psalm 19:7-14 describes God's special revelation. God's word is a revealing only to those who dig in and listen to the Holy Spirit. What does it mean that the Bible is perfect? sure? right? pure? true and righteous?

2. How does digging into God's special revelation revive our soul? Make us wise? Rejoice our heart?

3. Please describe how the fear (worship and awe) of the Lord is clean, enduring forever?

4. Verse 10 says God's word is more to be desired than gold or honey. What does that mean?

5. Please give examples of how the word gives both warning and reward. Do you have a harder time seeing its warning or its reward? Please explain your answer.

6. Please read verse 12 along with Jeremiah 17:9 and Hebrews 4:12. Which is the path to forgiveness, growth and healing – trusting my heart or trusting scripture? Why?

7. How is your worship of God and trust of scripture grown from this passage?
