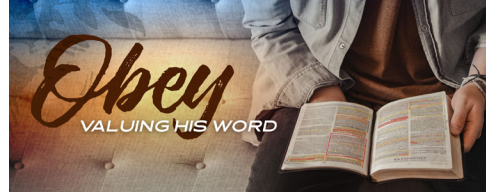

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 2 TIMOTHY 3:16-4:5

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Sufficient: In your life, trust and apply God's Word; Essential: Attend a Bible-centered church.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. If all scripture is breathed out by God and not just written by man, why do you think so few Christians read it?

2. Please use 1 Peter 3:8-9 to explain how that passage is profitable for ~

- a. Teaching (informing the head)

- b. Reproof (stirring the heart)

- c. Correction (challenging the will)

- d. Training in righteousness (informing, stirring, and challenging)

3. How does God's word make us complete (mature), equipped for every good work? What ways do we try to be complete and equipped apart from God's word?

4. From 2 Timothy 4:1-2,5, what are essential for a church on fire and humbly following God? How can we apply those commands to our own lives, and what distractions or challenges get in the way?

5. Please note that 2 Timothy 4:3-4 is referring to people who attend church. From these verses, what happens to people in the church when they choose not to study, know, and apply God's word to their lives?

6. What reasons do you see from this passage that inspire worship and service to God?
