KEY PASSAGE: PSALM 119:105-112

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Let God's Word light your path; Learn God's Word and apply it to your life; Thankfully celebrate the special guidance you have from your King.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. How does God's word light your path when you feel like you're in the dark?

2. How does God's word sustain you even in your affliction?

3. Is there a particular scripture you are or have held on to when under affliction? What do you think God is or may have been teaching you?

4. Please refer to Ephesians 6:10-19. What kind of spiritual attack have you noticed, and how does staying close to God and His word help sustain you?

5. In verse 108 we are called to praise no matter what. What attributes of God give you reason to praise Him even in the midst of the struggle?

6. From verse 111, what about God's word brings joy to your heart when the circumstances are still difficult?

7. What about the gospel of God makes you incline your heart to obey Him forever? What might you need to set down in order to be obedient to Him?
