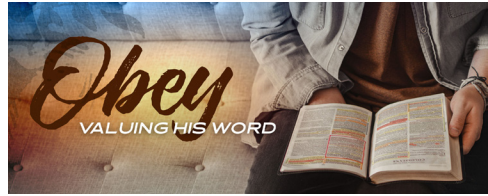

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 2 TIMOTHY 2:14-19

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Do not quarrel over words; Rightly apply God's Word; Avoid ungodly views and discussions.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Verse 14 starts out, "Remind them of these things." To what things is Paul referring?

2. Please use verses 16-18 to explain how quarreling about words and irreverent babble ruins the hearers. What is an example of things people are tempted to fight about in the church that might cause damage?

3. In the original Greek language, verse 15a says, "Hasten to present (stand close beside) yourself approved (tested) to God." What insight does this give you about our motivation in presenting ourselves to God?

4. According to verse 15, what is the best defense for not quarreling about words?

5. From the sermon, OPA (Observation, Principles, Application) is an approach to rightly handling the Word of God. Define the OPA steps with some examples.

6. How does getting caught into fights over words or irreverent babble keep us from presenting ourselves to God? How would a heart of anger, foolishness, fear, or despair get caught up into those conversations?

7. How does verse 19 help confirm a confidence in your faith? A clarity in your calling?
