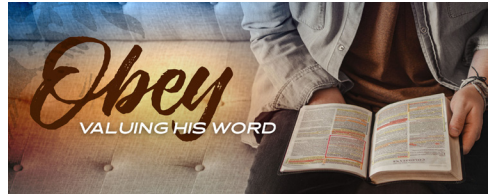

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: MATTHEW 28:16-20

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Worship Jesus as the One true God, who has all authority. (16-18); Follow Jesus and make disciples, teaching and baptizing. (19-20)*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. From vs. 16, who met Jesus in Galilee? Why did they go there?

2. From vs 17, what about seeing Jesus drew them to worship? Why do you think some may have still been doubting?

3. From vs 18, what was the major truth about Himself that He shared with the disciples? Why was it important to grasp that major truth about Jesus?

4. What does it mean to “make disciples”? Why was it important to see this command as applying to “all nations”?

5. Keeping in mind that the symbol of baptism does not save us, why do you think Jesus commanded the use of “baptizing” when making disciples?

6. Keeping in mind that the symbol of baptism does not save us, why do you think Jesus commanded the use of “teaching” when making disciples?
