1. According to vs. 36, what motivated Jesus to speak of “the harvest”? What does that tell you about His heart?

2. What command did Jesus give in vs. 38? Why do you think He gave this command to action before sending anyone to DO anything else?

From John 3:16-18

3. What words are used in this passage to show that salvation is not based on our works?

4. What is the reason that a person is “condemned”? For what reasons do we often think God would condemn someone?

5. Based on what you see in the two passages, please explain both our dependence on God and our responsibility to Him?
