IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: EPHESIANS 3:14-21

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Pray that the church will be strengthened with the Holy Spirit's power; Pray that the church will be grounded in the depths and riches of Jesus' love; Pray that the Father will stun us with all that He is about to do.*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Ephesians 3:14-21 and answer the following questions:

1. Please explain the source of our power according to vs. 14-16. What are the implications of this when we are trying to do things in our own strength?

2. Vs. 17 starts with the words "so that", implying that there is a purpose for our need to be strengthened. Please share everything listed in vs. 17-19 that shows what we receive strength for.

3. Vs. 18 uses the word "comprehend" regarding God's love "that surpasses knowledge", and vs. 19 uses the word "know" (by personal experience). What is the difference between comprehending and knowing?

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4. Please note the tie between vs. 15, the words “with all the saints” in vs. 18, and the words “in the church” in vs. 21. Why do you think Paul is emphasizing these words in context of God’s “love that surpasses knowledge”?
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5. What attributes of God do you see in vs. 14-21 that compel Paul to say, “to HIM be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever”?

What is one thing from this passage that you will apply to your life—in your actions, thoughts, or desires—to better center your worship on the Lord?
