KEY PASSAGE: PSALM 139:1-12

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? Satisfy your God-given desire for security and approval in your almighty, all-knowing, all-loving God; Satisfy your God-given desire for comfort and affirmation in your ever-present God of love.

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Psalm 139:1-12 and answer the following questions:

1. Please list the verbs (action words) attributed to God in verses 2-4 to explain how God has searched and known us. Which of those is most impactful to you? Why?

2. What happens when we expect other people to behave in the way God does?

3. With God having the ability to know everything about us, what hope does verse 5 give you? What fears or concerns might you have if verse 5 wasn't there?

4. From verses 1-6, how might God satisfy the God-given desires for security and approval?

5. From verses 7-10, what fears or concerns would you have if verse 10 wasn't there? What hope does verse 10 give you?

6. From verses 7-12, how might God satisfy the God-given desires for affirmation and comfort?

7. What truths from this passage bring you the most security from your relationship with the Lord?
