3. Why do you think God changes us from one degree of glory to the next rather than all at one time?

Ephesians 5:18-21

4. Please describe the behaviors and thoughts of a person who is drunk. How can you relate those behaviors and actions to a person who is filled by the Holy Spirit?

5. Verses 19-21 details all the actions of a person who is filled with the Holy Spirit. Please give examples of those actions as well as their opposite meanings.

6. What character traits of God from these passages inspire you to turn to Him and let His Spirit fill you?
