KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 3:8-15

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Hide: Watch for times when you cover up in shame; Blame: Watch for times when you try to find a cause for your sin outside of yourself.*

Please read Genesis 3:8-15 and answer the following questions:

1. What happened to the relationship between Adam and Eve and God when they ate the fruit?

2. How did Adam and Eve's response to God reflect...

a. Pride?

b. Shame?

3. How did Adam and Eve choose to shift blame when they were caught in their sin? Why are we tempted to blame-shift?

4. What do you learn about the effectiveness of hiding and blame-shifting in verses 16-17?

5. What veiled hope is given for the answer to our sin in verse 15?

6. How does this passage shine a spotlight on God's mercy? What about His all-sufficient grace?
