

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 KINGS 19:1-18

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *The Poison: My pride and unbelief lead to doubt over whether God really cares about me; The Symptom: I strive to satisfy the desires for comfort and affirmation "in me", so I wallow in self-pity, paralyzed by a sense of hopelessness; The Prescription: Encounter my caring and providing God. Repent and find hope in Him as you see Him, listen to Him, and follow Him.*

Please read 1 Kings 19:1-18 and answer the following questions:

1. Please look back at 1 Kings 18:20-46 and explain the reasons Elijah had to celebrate God.

2. What do you think Elijah's reaction to Jezebel's threat tells you about his doubting heart? How did he try to justify his doubts in 1 Kings 19:10, 14?

3. How are we often tempted to view God when we go through circumstances that cause us to doubt?

4. In this passage, what actions of God show His...

a. Mercy?

b. Power?

c. Compassion?

5. Please use the following passages to explain how we can cooperate with the Lord in surrendering our doubts.

a. Psalm 94:17-19

b. Psalm 105:4-5

c. Psalm 119:49-50
