

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: NUMBERS 20:2-13

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *The Poison: My pride and unbelief lead to rebellion and disobedience; The Symptom: I strive to satisfy the desires for control and authority "in me", so I rise up in self-rule, showing anger as I make myself the judge of what is right; The Prescription: Encounter my great God. Repent, surrender to His authority, and count on His mercy.*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Numbers 20:2-13 and answer the following questions:

1. How did the people's behavior toward Moses show their own pride and unbelief, especially after all God had done to rescue them from slavery in Egypt?

2. How did Moses and Aaron respond to the people's attack in verse 6?

3. How do Moses' and Aaron's actions in verses 10-11 disobey God's directions and show their own hearts of self-rule?

4. From verse 12:

a. What did God say Moses and Aaron failed to do?

b. How are we tempted to do the same thing in our circumstances?

c. What were the consequences of their actions? How much worse could it have been for them (and us) if God poured out His full wrath?

5. What do you see in this passage that displays God's...

a. Authority?

b. Power?

c. Wisdom?

d. Mercy?
