IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: TITUS 2:1-10

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *As a seasoned, mature believer, be a great model by what you teach and live; Partner with the younger generation to ensure that they have an on-fire walk with Jesus; Whatever your age or position in life, honor God through your doctrine and life.*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Titus 2:1-10 and answer the following questions:

1. Please read Titus 2:1-3. Paul is writing to Titus to help him establish and strengthen the church. From the passage, what does it look like for older, more mature men and women to live out a life of sound doctrine?

2. How is the call for older men different from older women? How is it the same?

3. Please read Titus 2:4-6. How is the church meant to impact the younger generations? What are several ways you could think of to have that impact?

4. Why is it important to recognize our role as a model for others? From verses 7-8, what are they actually to model? In your opinion, what would be the hardest to model consistently?

5. Doctrine is essential to know, believe, and live. Which is the hardest for you?

6. What do you learn about the heart of God based on the things He wants believers to learn and teach? How did Jesus model these things?
