. According to verse 15, what did God do with Adam, and what purpose did He give Adam? From the sermon, how are those two purposes similar to the priestly work later described for Israel in the tabernacle?		

4.	What permission and what warning did God give Adam in verses 16-17?
5.	1 Corinthians 10:13 says, "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and He will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it." Why do you think God allowed the possibility of disobedience for Adam? How did God provide a way of escape for him?
6.	What evidence of God's power, authority, and love do you see in this passage that makes Him worthy of our worship?
