KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 2:18-25

1. Why do you think God had Adam name the animals before bringing Eve to him?

2. How did God make Eve? How does this bring significance to the relationship between a man and a woman?

3. What insight does Adam's response toward Eve (when he first saw her) give you about his relationship with her versus his relationship with the animals?

4. What insights do you gain about how God sees marriage from verse 24?

5. Why do you think God said a man shall leave his father and mother when Adam and Eve had no father or mother? What does this tell you about God's plan for us as His people?

6. From verse 25, what is significant about the type of relationship God reserves for husband and wife?

7. This world is pressing hard for a world view that sees one's gender through only the lens of feelings rather than looking to the physical body. From the following verses, why must my body that I am born with be a key part of my actual identity?

a. Psalm 139:13-14

b. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

c. Romans 12:1

d. Jeremiah 17:9
