KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 3:14-24

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Genesis 3:14-24 and answer the following:

1. According to Genesis 3:15, what hope was God giving in the midst of declaring the consequences mankind would face for Adam and Eve's sin?

2. Please read Genesis 3:15 and Romans 16:19-20. How does Romans 16:19 refute the serpent's enticement to Eve in Genesis 3:5?

3. What was Eve's curse, and how do you see that curse still true today?

4. What was Adam's curse, and how do you see that curse still true today?

5. Part of the curse to Eve involved the relationship with her husband. How does Ephesians 5:33 call believers to live as overcomers of the curse?

6. How was God's choice to remove Adam and Eve from the Garden of Eden both a consequence and a protection for them?

7. Hebrews 13:8 says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." What attributes of God do you see in Genesis 3:14-24, and how do you see them still true today?
