Please read Genesis 5:1–32 and answer the following:				
Genesis 1:28 and Genesis 3:19 are two promises of God (one positive and one negative). How do you see them both fulfilled in the same world at the same time in Gensis 5?				
2. Genesis 5:21-24, introduces Enoch. What do we learn about him? What is very different about how his life ends compared to all the others listed in the passage?				
3. From Hebrews 11:5 and Jude 1:14-15, what did Enoch's walk look like?				

4.	From Genesis 5:21-27, Methuselah is described. What blessing do you see for him? Methuselah's name has several meanings, one being "when death is sent." What significance does that have when looking at the timeline chart of Adam to Noah?
5.	This world offers so many off ramps to sin and self. Those described in Genesis 5 were watching humanity collapse, and yet were a blessed blood line. From 1 Peter 1:17-19, what encouragement and what challenge do you find about how we should live today?
6.	A definition of God's sovereignty is that He has control over everything, and He makes things happen, allows things to happen, and disallows things to happen. What evidence do you see in this passage of His sovereignty?
