3.	According to Genesis 7:5, 9, and 16, how did Noah display his faith in God's word?			
4.	What place does humility have in obedience to the Lord. What evidence of humility do you see in Noah?			
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5.	According to Genesis 7:16, who closed the door of the ark? From the sermon, what does that tell you about the security of our salvation?
6.	How do you see God's active involvement throughout this passage?
7.	What attributes of God do we need to believe about Him in order for our faith to lead us to obedience? What obstacles get in the way of trusting these things about Him?
