## KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 10:1-32

### INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

*Please read Genesis 10:1-32 and answer the following:*

1. Please look back at Genesis 9:24-27. What did Noah say about his sons ~ Ham, Japheth, and Shem?

2. When people finally began to move and spread out, which one of Noah's sons (and offspring) moved North? South? Remained in Middle East?

3. Please look at the names of the descendants of Ham, especially Canaan's lineage. What insight do these descendants give you about the curse on Ham's son, Canaan? Consider the following examples...

- a. Egypt - Exodus 14

- b. The Philistines - 1 Samuel 17

c. Sodom and Gomorrah - Genesis 19

4. From the sermon, what does the name Peleg mean? From verse 25, what happened during the lifetime of Peleg that made his name so meaningful?

5. What insight does Genesis 10:5, 20, and 30 give you about how the sons' descendants were dispersed?

6. From the sermon, what circumstances caused the people to disperse post-flood?
