IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: GENESIS 11:10-12:3

Please read Genesis 11:10-12:3 and answer the following:

1. From the list of names and their offspring, what do you see about the changes in lifespan after Peleg? Please use Genesis 10:25 to explain the significance of that change.

2. From Joshua 24:2, why might God have waited until Abram's father, Terah, died before He told Abram to go "to a land" that He would show him?

3. Please read Genesis 12:1 and 12:5. Where was God sending Abram to live? How does this carry out God's plan from Genesis 9:25-27?

4. Please read Genesis 11:4 and Genesis 12:2. How was one's name to be made great in the plans of man in Genesis 11:4? How was Abram's name to be made great in Genesis 12:2?

5. How does the blessing promised to Abraham at the end of Genesis 12:3 echo the promise of Genesis 3:15?

6. What insight does God's involvement in His plan for Abraham give you about His power, purposes, and plans in your present circumstances?
