# IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS KEY PASSAGE: ZEPHANIAH 3:14-20

#### INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. What commands are given in this passage (vs. 14 and 16)?

2. What reasons are given for our obedience to the commands. (vs. 15 and 17-18)?

3. Please list God's actions described in verses 17-18 and list the opposite of those actions. How does that impact your view of God?

4. In verses 19-20, God says what He will do "at that time," meaning that His restoration will be completely fulfilled in His future millennial kingdom when Christ will reign. How does knowing that whatever we face today is not the end of the story impact the way you face your current struggles?

- Please list what verses 19-20 say He WILL do, and use the following verses to explain what He IS DOING until "that time" when we are completely restored by the Lord:
  - a. Matthew 11:28-30

b. Romans 8:26-29

c. Philippians 4:4-7

d. Isaiah 41:13

6. What do you see about God in this passage that strengthens your hope in Him?
