	1 Read Mark 10:45 and talk about what it means to serve others and what that looks like.	2 Pray about who in your life you can serve this week.	3 Ask God to help each person to have a helpful attitude at home and help each other with this.	4 Pray for workers who serve others (police, nurses, etc.).	5 At dinner, talk about why serving others matters to Jesus.	6 Do a full family chore day—work together for 20 minutes.
7 After church, ask: “Where can our family serve this week?”	8 Read Philippians 2:3–4 and talk about putting others first.	9 Pray for hearts that will help and serve one another.	10 Pray for cooperation and teamwork in your home.	11 Pray for the kids and volunteers participating in Camp Community.	12 Share a time when obeying God was hard.	13 Help a neighbor with yard work or a small task.
14 Thank God for the example of Jesus as a servant.	15 Read James 1:22 and talk about doing—not just hearing.	16 Ask God to help you not complain, but have a heart of thankfulness.	17 Pray for patience and self-control.	18 Pray for kids who don’t have enough food or support.	19 Share how serving can show God’s love.	20 Make and deliver a small treat to someone!
21 Reflect: “How did we serve this week?”	22 Read Galatians 5:13 and talk about serving in love.	23 Pray for joyful hearts while serving.	24 Pray for unity and kindness at home.	25 Pray for missionaries and people serving far away.	26 Share one way your family served someone this month.	27 Choose a family service project (park cleanup, donation, etc.).
28 Thank God for giving you chances to serve.	29 Read Matthew 5:16 and talk about letting your light shine.	30 Thank God for helping your family grow in serving others.
