1 After church, say to one another: "Jesus rescues you from sin and all your fears".	2 Read Psalm 40:1-2 together and ask: "What can we God ask to help us with today?"	3 Thank God for being your Rescuer.	4 Hold hands and pray for protection in mind, body, and spirit.	5 While driving, pray for the people walking or in cars.	6 At dinner, remind the table why we need a Savior. "We are sinners and need saving."	7 Who can you invite to a Lent or the Easter service? Invite them!
8 Pray together: Thank God that He is always with us, protecting us.	9 Read Luke 19:10 and talk about who Jesus came for. Pray for people in your life to know Jesus.	10 Before you start your school day, ask God to rescue your family from fear or worry.	11 Pray together that you would turn to God first in hard times.	12 Pray for a family you know that may be struggling.	13 Each of you- finish the sentence: "Jesus rescues me from _____."	14 Encourage someone with a meal, visit, or a kind note. Pray for them.
15 Remind each other that "Jesus restores what is broken".	16 Read 2 Corinthians 5:17 and name one new beginning you're thankful for.	17 Remember your Baptism and ask God to daily drown your sin and raise you to new life in Christ.	18 Pray for peace in your home- your bodies and minds.	19 While driving, pray for people who feel lost or discouraged.	20 In the car, each person share one way God helped them today or this week.	21 Fix or clean something in your home as a reminder of restoration.
22 As a family, think about a time something hard happened. How did God help bring good from it."	23 Read 1 Peter 5:10 and talk about all the things God can restore.	24 In the morning take turns thanking God for how He brings healing, forgiveness, and new beginnings.	25 There can be brokenness in relationships- who can you pray for today?	26 Pray for people recovering from sickness.	27 Remind each other how Jesus gives forgiveness after mistakes and sin.	28 It's easy for people to feel overwhelmed. How can you help them?
29 Jesus is the King of Kings! Remind each other that "Jesus protects and provides for us!".	30 Read Isaiah 61:1 and talk about someone you can share the Good News of Jesus with.	31 Easter is coming! Thank God for rescuing and restoring your family from your sin.
