

RETURN, REBUILD, RESIST

JUDAH WENT INTO CAPTIVITY IN BABYLON IN THREE PHASES:

- **1. 605 B.C.**—Among those taken were Daniel and friends.
- 2. 597 B.C.—Including Ezekiel and 10,000 captives
- **3. 586 B.C.**—All remaining and the temple was destroyed.

THE RETURN CAN ALSO BE DIVIDED INTO THREE PHASES:

- **1. 536 B.C.**—Zerubbabel returned and began rebuilding the temple.
- **2. 458 B.C.**—Ezra returned with offerings and a decree from the king.
- **3. 445 B.C.**—Nehemiah returned and rebuilt the wall.
