FAQ

HOW DO I BECOME A MEMBER OF NEWSPRING?

Through salvation and baptism. Christians are people who believe that the blood of Jesus Christ, shed on the cross, provides the sole basis for the forgiveness of sin. Therefore, salvation occurs only when a person places his or her faith in the death and resurrection of Christ as the sufficient payment for his or her sin. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, then you are ready to be baptized. Your baptism is an opportunity to show others that you have accepted Christ and are now walking with Him.

BY STATEMENT OF FAITH

If you have accepted Jesus Christ and have been baptized, you can join NewSpring Church through a statement of faith. This is a personal testimony that you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and were subsequently scripturally baptized by immersion.

CAN I VOLUNTEER IF I'M NOT A MEMBER?

Yes, in some ministries you can volunteer without officially becoming a member. However, being a member sends a message that you are completely and fully ready to help NewSpring accomplish its mission.

WHY SHOULD I BECOME A MEMBER? WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

When you become a member of NewSpring, you are saying that you are completely engaged in what we do and what we teach. You are "officially" joining the team. On a very practical level, being a member allows you to participate in annual business meetings.

HOW DO I GET BAPTIZED?

Since we are not part of a denomination, we do not have human authorities outside our church that give us direction. We believe that Jesus Christ is the head of our church and that God has placed the leadership here at NewSpring to help us live out the vision. There are two elected bodies at NewSpring—our deacons and our trustees. Deacons help meet the spiritual needs of NewSpringers. Trustees create and oversee the budget, which the congregation votes on in our annual meeting. Lead Pastor Mark Hoover is the key leader for all ministry decisions of the church.
