Christmas in July, 2023

Stewpot (one of our Fave Five ministries) is in constant need of replenishing their Food Pantry. As food prices have gone up, it is increasingly difficult for many families to stretch their food budget, and Stewpot helps fill that need.

So now it's time for "Christmas in July", and Meadowbrook will once again be gathering food donations for the Stewpot Food Pantry. Stewpot personnel screen the applicants to insure eligibility. The Pantry is open five days a week to individuals and families who qualify based on their level of income and who are unable to afford enough food to feed themselves or their families. Nonperishable food items are requested. A list of suggested items will be handed out on Sunday, July 16, and will also be available on the foyer table.

Boxes will be placed in the foyer of the auditorium and in the hall outside the Family Center for your donations from July 16 - August 13. As you shop for groceries for yourselves, please put some extra in your cart for those who are less fortunate. Thank you for being the hands and feet of Jesus to our neighbors here in Jackson.

The Priority and Potency of Prayer

The next time you read through a Gospel (especially Luke) count how many times Jesus either prays or says something about prayer.

- And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.
(Mark 1:35)
- One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. (Luke 6:12)

The disposition of the early church was one of prayerfulness.

The potency of prayer is experienced when trying to make wise decisions. Before Jesus chose his twelve apostles (Luke 6:13-16), he spent the whole night in prayer. Prayer sometimes leads to surprising decisions that could only be made after communing with God.
