### **“I Love Jesus, but Not His Church”?**

Jesus is easy to love, but what about the church? Can we choose to love Jesus, but reject the church?

As Jesus prepared to ascend into heaven, His disciples had questions (Acts 1:6). Did they wonder what to do without Jesus? What was next? If the church was man's idea, we could take it or leave it. Since the church was God's idea (Isaiah 2; Daniel 2; Joel 2; Acts 2), we must take it.

“A man who isolates himself seeks his own desire; he rages against all wise judgement” (Proverbs 18:1) The Israelites were called a “congregation in the wilderness” (Acts 7:38). God's house, the church, stands on the foundation of the apostles and prophets. Jesus is the chief cornerstone. God's eternal plan was for Christians to be joined to Jesus and to each other. There is no relationship with Jesus without a relationship with His church. To love Jesus, we must also love His church.
