The Greek word for “rejoicing” is used in the New Testament 72 times. It is a word that induces an intense emotional response from those who hear or see the word.

Joy is a word of depth. It speaks about the inner person and what is going on inside the heart and mind. Joy is the ability to remain upbeat and positive under the extreme weight of pain, discouragement, and trouble.

Joy is a word of width. It remains with an individual no matter how wide the temptations of life may be.

Joy is a word of height. It makes the heart soar above the troubles of the world.

Joy is a word of length. Jesus told His disciples that the joy He provided them has no expiration date.

Joy certainly is the vehicle that allows us to endure to the end without becoming cynical or discouraged. We need to be joyful people because of its value for our lives.
