Why did the Holy Spirit come so dramatically?

The Spirit's appearance at Pentecost was tumultuous - rushing winds, flames of fire, a cacophony of languages being spoken at once, shouting and confusion. But it wasn't show over substance. The effects were dramatic because they represented the birth of Christ's church and the inauguration of the mystery by which Jews and Gentiles would be brought together in one body around Jesus Christ.
