

A nursing mother's room is located on the first floor off of the Fellowship Hall.

For kids ages 3 through kindergarten, we offer "children's worship" during the sermon. After worshipping with their family during the first part of the service, kids ages 3 through kindergarten will be invited to join our leaders at the front of the sanctuary. After the sermon, the kids return to the sanctuary to meet their parents.


God Calls Us To Worship

We Pray For God To Help Us Worship

We ask the Lord to work in us by his Holy Spirit to give us the desire and ability to respond to him in worship. Christ is risen!

By the power of your Spirit, please help us live as your spiritual household, rejoicing to draw near to you in worship and reflecting the glory of your truth and grace to the world. Amen.




