## **Sermon Discussion Questions**

### **Sunday, August 24, 2025**

### **“Life in Retrospect”**

#### **Psalm 32**

#### **Pastor Clay Smith**

- David describes the blessedness of the one whose sins are forgiven (Psalm 32:1–2). How does the assurance of God’s forgiveness bring freedom and true happiness in your daily life?
- Hiding or excusing sin only leads to shame, and weariness (vv. 3–4). In what ways are we tempted to “cover up” our sin instead of confessing it, and what are the consequences of doing so?
- Repentance is not just turning away from sin but turning toward God (v. 5). What practices or rhythms help you live a lifestyle of repentance and keep your heart open before God?
- Psalm 32 shows that forgiveness leads not only to freedom from guilt but also to new life with God (vv. 8–11). How does God’s promise to instruct and counsel us shape the way you think about obedience and growth in holiness?
