“Waiting for Jesus’ Grace”
Jeremiah 33:12-16

1. Where do you feel most like Jeremiah— “in a double prison”—right now?

How does God’s promise that hard is not the last word help re-shape how you wait in those places of fear, uncertainty, or frustration?

2. Jeremiah calls God’s people to “look again” with the eyes of faith.

What are some areas in your life where you may need to “look again” to see evidence of God’s work, even when circumstances outwardly feel waste-like or barren?

3. The sermon reminds us that Jesus, the Righteous Branch, is already on the throne.

How does the truth that Jesus reigns right now change the way you respond to the worries you carry—for your family, the church, or the world?

4. The “new pajamas” illustration pictures Advent promises as a uniform for waiting.

What specific promise of God functions like that for you—something you “put on” to help you wait with hope and expectation for Christ’s return?
