- In this passage, the townspeople seem to value their pigs and economic security more than the healing of one man. Where are we tempted to value comfort, stability, or self-protection more than people?

- Where has Jesus brought healing, freedom, or change in your own life, and how might he be calling you to turn that into a testimony for others?
