“Following Jesus Before Doing for Jesus”

Luke 10: 38-42

1. What was new, different, or challenging from this message?
2. What are some of the good things important to you on which sometimes you stake your identity and become anxious, consumed, irritable, despairing, judgmental of others and yourself?
3. Interact with the following quote by Charles Spurgeon: “Her [Martha’s] fault was not that she served. The condition of a servant well becomes every Christian. Her fault was that she grew ‘cumbered with much serving,’ so that she forgot him and only remembered the service.”
4. Discuss the fact that your works for God don’t define you nor does your sin define you. God defines you as his dearly loved child through your faith in Jesus Christ. How does living out of that identity affect the way you love and work to restore other broken people to life?
5. Discuss Tim Keller’s idea of “love economics” – having enough love “in the bank” to be generous in love to others. And how does it pertain to abiding with Jesus?
6. What does the truth that Jesus “sees” you and loves you just like he did Martha mean to you?
