- 1) Jesus is teaching through a parable that since this world is passing away and the eternal one remains, our actions now have eternal consequences. When you hear that, what does that mean to you?
- 2) One of the characters in Jesus’ parable is a named man Lazarus, which means God has helped. Lazarus was deeply impoverished in the world but it is a reminder that no matter how poor, how unloved, how unwanted you are, no matter what this life has done to you, you are loved by God. Who has God put in your life (or maybe even yourself) that you need to share this message with that they (you) are truly loved?
- 3) The rich man in Jesus’ parable is a great warning for many of us as it describes many of us that are self-absorbed. Jesus calls us to love God and to love others and they stand together and are not independent of each other. How are you doing in loving your neighbor as a reflection of your love for God?
