“The Great Exchange”
2 Corinthians 5:16—6:2

1. What was new, different, or challenging from this message?
2. God reconciles us to himself by making Jesus our substitute. What does that mean?
3. Interact with the following: “Forgiveness is not cheap, is not facile. It is costly. Reconciliation is not an easy option. It cost God the death of His Son.”
4. God reconciles us by making us the beneficiary of Jesus’ righteousness. What does that mean?
5. Interact with the following: “When God looks at you today, He sees you clothed in the perfect, sinless obedience of His Son. And when He says, ‘This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased,’ He includes you in that warm embrace.”
6. What does it mean to “regard no one according to the flesh,” and why is that important in the work of being reconcilers to which God has called us?
7. Interact with the following: “God’s verdict on our sin condemns us all and destroys any illusions of superiority or inferiority. Jew and Greek, slave and free, male and female are all on the same level before God. The church is called to be an abnormal witness, a living billboard for the world to come. This happens when we realize in practice that the old has passed away and the new has come.”
