



Excerpts from October 10, 2023 Church Board Meeting

Call to order 5:58PM by Moderator Brad Losch. Judy Ferguson gave the opening devotion and prayer. Minutes from the September 12, 2023, meeting were approved by general consensus.

Pastor's Report: Ministers report was attached. Pastor Michael highlighted a few aspects of his report including building team meetings will continue, the vote of the church was conveyed to the builder.

Treasurer: Michelle Hart submitted a report and Rebecca Rhodes presented information from the report—as of September 30, 2023: Unrestricted Operating Checking \$100,000. The total transfer to the building fund in September was \$1,004.69. Total Funds Available for Construction/Renovation \$1,532,752.20

It was pointed out that the amount the church has made in interest so far this year is \$29,234.79 which most of that is from the CDs that are being invested. Steve Tharp moved to approve the Treasurer's Report and Hamer Tate seconded. Passed unanimously.

Christian Education: Sunday School on Youth Sunday will be 8:45 to 9:45AM. It was discussed how to get the youth group to the Tate farm for the Vesper Service. It was decided the bus would pick them up at 5PM at Crossroads and return at 8PM.

Nominating Committee Report – Roger Brokaw provided the proposed nominees for the upcoming year as follows: Moderator Brad Losch, Vice Moderator Brandi Pennock, Treasurer Eleanor Jenkins, Recording Secretary Libby Boren, Trustee Justin Poor; Elders: Charlotte Dunham, Wayne Chamberlain, David Bishop, and Bob Clark; Deacons: Justin and Amber Poor, Landon Poor, Lucas Poor, Jason and Erica Thomas, Gary and Carol Sherwin, Luke Fesler, Rodney Gordley, Jordan Lamb, and Joyce Harrison. Leecia Carnes made a motion to accept the slate of nominations and submit to the congregation for a vote at the next congregational meeting. Steve Tharp seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Staff members were asked to leave the room while the board discussed the proposed 2024 budget. Brad Losch went over the proposed budget with the board. The proposed budget is \$26,697 more than last year's budget. This accounts mostly for the following reasons: A) An increase in utilities that affects all the building properties. B) There is a 3% increase to non-new positions and the addition of the Christian Ed position due to expansion in that area which was not in the previous year's budget. C) Increase in Illinois minimum wage again this year.

Music: Kayla Boren submitted a report. She added that the Christmas caroling will be on December 10, 2023. Also, there is a November 12th worship soak service. She needs people to do pre-recorded narrations for the Cantata.

Building Team: Brad Losch provided an update. The building committee will continue to meet weekly. They did notify the builder, the banker, and the insurance company. Work will need to be on the fence that is around the large hole now on the property. They are welcome to all ideas and will be exploring all avenues.

The motion to adjourn was made by Judy Ferguson and seconded by Matt Saxe. The motion passed unanimously, and the meeting adjourned at 6:47PM.
